Forty hi-tech parking lots to come up in city

Hyderabad: About 30 to 40 multi-level car parking complexes equipped with 'advanced technologies' will be built in the city under the Public Private Partnership (PPP) model, with Hyderabad Metro Rail Limited (HMRL) as the coordinating agency.

All the multi-level parking lots will be part of the Integrated Smart Parking Management System of the Telangana police department, said Municipal Administration and Urban Development (MAUD) department principal secretary Arvind Kumar, on Wednesday.

The announcement was made after a meeting held between the principal secretary and the managing director of HMRL, NVS Reddy at Metro Rail Bhavan.

According to Kumar, the Request For Proposal (RFP) for these multi-level car parking complexes will be floated soon.

big way in Hyderabad' asked officers of various departments to come up with specific proposals about their requirement in plots identified by them for multi-level car parking complexes.

The meeting was also attended by additional DGP (law & order) Jitender, Hyderabad Metropolitan Development Authority (HMDA) commissioner T Chiranjeevulu and officials from the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC), Telangana State Road Transport Corporation (TSRTC), Telangana State Industrial Infrastructure Corporation (TSIIC) and other state departments such as transport and agriculture and marketing. Senior engineers of HMRL were also present at the meeting.
