

Metro Rail office shifts to Begumpet

The office of the Hyderabad Metro Rail Limited, which was hitherto functioning partly from the old Metro Rail Bhavan at Saifabad and partly from the new Metro Rail corporate office at Begumpet, on Wednesday been fully shifted to the new building.

The new corporate office at Begumpet is built on 2,000 square yards of land as a five-storied building with a built-up area of about 50,000 sft. It is an environmental-friendly building with natural ventilation, aesthetics, and a garden developed around the building, according to an official release here.

HMRL managing director NVS Reddy said the new building, built at

a cost of around Rs 10 crore by HMRL engineers with state-of-the-art facilities, has set new standards in terms of economy and amenities.

The HMRL office was operating from a government property owned by the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation and five apartments near to the old office in Saifabad.
