# Delhi team inspects Metro Phase II corridors

Hyderabad Metro Rail Limited (HMRL) officials along with Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) team inspected the potential Metro Phase II corridors to examine alternative alignments for Airport Metro Express connectivity from different Metro phase-I terminal points and to provide options for government for prioritising Metro Phase-II routes.

This inspection was done as part of preparing a Detailed Project Report (DPR) for phase-II of Hyderabad Metro Rail project. The technical experts and engineers of DMRC and HMRL have been conducting field

surveys, traffic and transportation studies, soil testing, among others in different parts of the city from last three months.

On Saturday, DMRC Managing Director Mangu Singh and HMRL Managing Director NVS Reddy inspected the potential Metro phase-II corridors.

Later, they conducted a brainstorming session at Metro Rail Bhavan for en-

hancement of revenue and reduction in cost of construction.

During the session, engineers and town planners of DMRC and HMRL were advised to give importance for ridership enhancement, maximum comfort and convenience for passengers through inter-modal integration and incorporation of latest technologies.

They also advised the field engineers and other officers to expedite all the required studies and complete DPR preparation for Metro phase-II by June end this year. DMRC Director SD Sharma, HMRL Railway Chief Engineers Pancham (Civil), DVS Raju (Electrical) and others participated in the session.
