

Metro Rail to launch two more malls

Combining Metro connectivity with shopping experience in more parts of the city, the L&T Metro Rail Hyderabad Limited (LTMRHL) is gearing up to open two more malls at Erramanzil and Moosarambagh, coinciding with the launch of commercial operations of Metro services on the Ameerpet-LB Nagar route in about two months.

Efforts are being made to commence Metro services on the 16-km Ameerpet-LB Nagar route by the end July. The plan is to open the two malls around the same time.

"All the works are almost complete and commercial establishments fitouts are

being installed. Decathlon is making arrangements for setting up its new store in

Erramanzil mall," said a senior Metro official. After the Punjagutta mall, Erramanzil

is the second biggest LTM-RHL mall spread over 3.25 lakh square feet. (SEE PAGE 2)

Metro Rail gears up to launch two more malls

The one at Moosarambagh is coming up on 2.30 lakh sqft. LTMRHL opened Punjagutta and Hitec City Malls last year and a major portion of the space is already occupied. These malls have multiplex theatres, food courts, electronic showrooms, garment stores and so on. The malls at Erramanzil and

Moosarambagh too will have multiplexes and other outlets facilitating Metro commuters to shop, eat and rejuvenate, the official said. Trial runs on the Ameerpet-LB Nagar route will be conducted soon. Hyderabad Metro officials operated the Catenary Maintenance Vehicle on the route on Saturday to check the

functioning of different components, including overhead electrical lines. After hoisting the Tricolour at Metro Bhavan as part of State Formation Day celebrations, HMRL MD NVS Reddy said works were being taken up at a brisk pace on Ameerpet-Hitec City route (10 km) and JBS-MGBS route (10km).
