

# Multi-level car parking in PPP mode to end city woes soon?

**Hyderabad:** To overcome parking issues in the city, Telangana chief secretary SK Joshi directed municipal administration officials to call for expression of interest from private parties for construction of multi-level parking complexes under Public Private Partnership (PPP) within a month.

The chief secretary directed officials to conduct feasibility studies on proposals received from private parties. The officials have to incorporate package details and other issues, in the terms of reference,

Multi-level parking would be developed under Public Private Partnership mode at 42 locations across the city, especially in core areas. Every parking complex will be considered one unit

before going for request for proposal from the developers.

Mayor Bonthu Rammohan, who participated in the meeting, said chain parking could be considered in areas between 100 sq yards to 500 sq yards land. Pointing out that cities like New York earn huge revenues in parking fees, he

said it was good time to adopt the best practices in the world. Principal secretary Arvind Kumar said the police department has conducted a survey on parking solutions, including the one in Sarojini Nagar, New Delhi, developed by DLF.

Hyderabad Metro Rail Limited is the nodal agency for construction of multi-level parking in the city. HMRL managing director NVS Reddy said countries like Germany, Japan, China and South Korea have been using the latest cutting edge technology for construction and maintenance of similar complexes.
