HMR cautions job aspirants against fake recruitments

Hyderabad Metro Rail Limited appealed to job aspirants not to fall prey to false recruitment drives. Cases were booked against two persons by the Rachakonda cyber cell on Friday. The duo promised jobs in HMRL for many and collected money.

These are fake. Earlier, gangs from New Delhi and other parts of north India indulged in such practices and now a few local gangs are getting involved, said HMRL Managing Director NVS Reddy. HMR is a public private partnership project and private sector norms are followed for recruitment. It is done through campus recruitment or notifications announced by Keolis, he said. "Instructions were issued to officials to recruit on merit basis with due priority to local candidates. Beyond this, HMR does not have any say," he said.
