Inspecting the concrete plinth beam and track works on Oliphenta bridge and at the critical gaps at Parade grounds, Begumpet and Ameerpet on Sunday (10.09.2017), MD, HMRL Mr.NVS Reddy along with MD, L&TMRHL Mr Shivanand Nimbargi complimented the engineers and skilled workers for their work ethos and commitment to quality. While it took about 6 months to reassemble the thousands of dismantled steel pieces which were brought from Ghaziabad (near Delhi) to Secunderabad on special containers, it took just 10 days to launch the mammoth 1100 ton Oliphenta steel bridge in its position. This was a world record to achieve such an engineering feat over crowded areas and busy Rail tracks and now the track works above the steel bridge are in full swing.

Adhering to the deadlines given by Chief Minister Mr K Chandrasekhar Rao to keep the entire stretch of 30 km from Nagole to Ameerpet and Ameerpet to Miyapur ready in all respects including safety certification from Commissioner of Metro Rail Safety (CMRS), both the MDs have assured Municipal Minister Mr KT Rama Rao that they have an internal target of October 15, 2017 for completing all the works and obtaining the safety certification from CMRS by November 15, 2017. Mr Reddy felt satisfied that different track works, electrification & signaling works, station works etc., are progressing as per schedule in these stretches.

MD, L&TMRHL Mr. Shivanand Nimbargi said that the project is getting completed at a fast pace due to the support of Government of Telangana and L&T is closely coordinating with HMRL. He added that L&TMRHL is also working on providing an appl to integrate with the other existing transport systems like TSRTC, MMTS, autos, Uber, Ola etc., so that the Metro users will have a seamless connectivity for their day to day travel, and the launch of Hyderabad Metro Rail by the Hon'ble Prime Minister will be a historic moment for Hyderabad.
