Delivering a 'Leadership Series' lecture on "Opportunities and Challenges" to a large gathering of young Management students at the Institute of Management Technology(IMT), Hyderabad campus today (Friday), MD, HMRL Mr. NVS Reddy advised them to set high goals and standards for themselves and urged them to be innovative rather than simply following the rut. Explaining them about the challenges of leadership during crisis periods and the need for perseverance and courage of conviction, he stated that it is important that one should learn to face failure, if one wants to make the impossible possible.

Giving example of the bold PPP experiment of Hyderabad Metro which was originally dismissed by many as a pipe dream, he explained as to how the project was made a reality, forcing even the experts to acknowledge its merits. Mr. Reddy briefed them that with many engineering and financial innovations and technological excellence, the project is nearing completion and once completed, it will stand as a testimony to the engineering talent and management skills of our country. He stated that two sections i.e., Miyapur-SR Nagar(11 km) of corridor I and Nagole-Begumpet(16 km) of corridor III will be opened mid this year and the whole of these two corridors (56 km) will be opened for traffic this year itself. Corridor II upto MGBS will be opened mid next year, he added.

MD, HMRL made a PPT presentation with photographs and media clippings of every day agitations against the Metro Rail project in the initial days and explained to the young MBA students as to how public opinion was turned around in favour of the project by systematic planning, transparent communication and precast engineering methods. He demonstrated to them the technological excellence of Hyderabad Metro project which involved sophisticated signalling and train control system, remote operation of trains from the computerised operating control centre (OCC), commuter friendly amenities and security features.



Briefing them as to how the project is diferent from the other Metro projects, he explained that Hyderabad Metro is not just a simple transportation project but it is an opportunity to redesign Hyderabad as an eco-friendly and people-friendly city with special facilities for women, children, senior citizens and differently abled people. Mr.Reddy goaded them to utilise their strengths and skills to solve the problems of ordinary people and serve the society with dedication and determination.
