MD, HMR Mr. NVS Reddy along with Addl. Commissioner of Police (Traffic), Hyderabad, Mr. Jitender conducted a joint inspection of Metro Rail corridor III works in Ameerpet - Yousufguda- Jubilee Hills- Hitec City stretch today.

While reviewing the progress of the Metro interchange station at Ameerpet, Mr.NVS Reddy instructed L&TMRHL engineers to take up parallel construction of both corridor I and corridor III structures so as to speed up the progress of this complicated interchange station. Sanctioning the work for covering the open nala with slab near Sarathi studio, he advised L&TMRHL engineers to start it immediately to facilitate entry and exit points of corridor III portion of the station. He has also instructed L&TMRHL engineers to widen the road on the newly acquired properties of timber depot etc., for better movement of traffic.

MD, HMR gave the following decisions/instructions during the inspection of the stretch between Ameerpet – Yousufguda – Jubilee Hills – Hitec City:

- Formation of proper footpath along the compound wall of Sarathi Studio for pedestrian usage.
- Widening the carriageway along Yousufguda-Madhuranagar stretch.
- Restoring the carriageway immediately between Madhuranagar and PJR statue in Yousufguda basti.
- Restore/relocate utilities to increase the carriageway for safety of commuters.
- Improve the road as an alternative road from KVB stadium to Jubilee Hills Road No. 2 via Venkatagiri to facilitate free traffic movement.

Additional CP (Traffic), Hyderabad Mr. Jitender advised L&TMRHL to remove construction equipment as and when construction is completed especially at high density traffic points and increase the carriageway. MD, HMR and Addl. CP suggested L&TMRHL to have timelines mentioned clearly on the barricades to ensure that works are completed as per the agreed deadlines.

Inspecting the plans for location of individual pillars in Hitec Cirty area, Mr.NVS Reddy advised L&TMRHL engineers to change the location of some of the proposed pillars so as not to obstruct free flow of traffic in this important stretch between Hitec City and Raidurg.

Project Director L&TMRHL Mr. MP Naidu, Chief Engineer, HMR Md. Ziauddin and other engineers and officers of HMR, L&TMRHL and traffic police department participated in the inspection.
