

Now, students can take 30 rides with Metro pass at the cost of 20

Hyderabad: Hyderabad Metro Rail has recently surpassed the milestone of serving 40 crore passengers since its inauguration on November 29, 2017. In light of this achievement, NVS Reddy, the managing director of HMRL, shared that the system currently caters to approximately 4,90,000 commuters each

day, with expectations of reaching 5,00,000 soon.

These daily passengers contribute to a total of 6,70,000 passenger trips. Reddy emphasised that the largest group of users consists of IT employees, with a daily count of 140,000, while students make up the second largest segment, with 120,000 passengers per day.

To further accommodate

students, starting from July 1, a new student pass will be introduced. This pass allows students, born after April 1, 1998, to enjoy 30 trips per month at the price of 20 trips. Reddy encouraged students to take advantage of this opportunity, enabling them to enhance their travel experience. The new student pass will be valid for 30 days from the date of purchase.
