Urban & rural development

The Chief Minister said both urban and rural areas of Telangana were thriving with robust infrastructure, cleanliness and greenery initiatives of the State government. The State government is implementing the Strategic Road Development Programme (SRDP) with a cost of Rs 67,149 crore to tackle traffic congestion and ensure a signal-free Hyderabad. Apart from the construction of 42 key roads with flyovers and underpasses, the government completed the development of 22 link roads.

Further, the Metro Rail expansion has been proposed with an estimated Rs 69,000 crore to cover 415 km, aimed at fulfilling urban transport needs.
