

2-DECKER MARVEL IN METRO-3

The Hyderabad Metro Rail's (HMRL) ambitious Phase 3 plan proposes to expand its network across the city covering almost all important regions.

The public transporter's plan features the ORR Metro as well two double-elevated stretches, which will have a flyover and a Metro line above it. According to HMRL's data, the ORR Metro will benefit citizens from around 50 key locations in the outskirts.

Land acquisitions and permissions will be key issues for Phase 3, especially for the double-elevated stretches, which will cut across several military areas in the twin cities. While no deadline has been set at this stage, the proposal will be worked upon and a pre-project report as well as a detailed project report will be prepared.

The HMRL will then explore funding options such as help from the central government or go for a Public Private Partnership model.

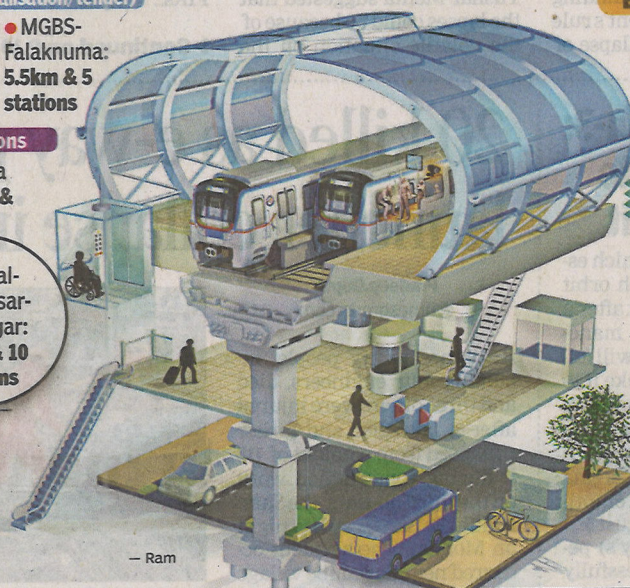
