NVS Reddy given one-year extension as Hyd Metro MD

Hyderabad: The Telangana govt issued orders extending the term of NVS Reddy as Hyderabad Metro Rail Limited (HMRL) managing director for one more year effective April 1, 2025.

He was among the 177 retired officers who were terminated by the municipal administration department last week.

However, the govt decided to extend his tenure for one more year as Phase-2 of the Hyderabad Metro project is set to take off, and the proposals and documentation for the project being



prepared.

"The services of NVS Reddy as managing director of HMRL and Hydera-

bad Airport Metro Limited are crucial as he is closely involved in these proposals, and retaining his services will help in the successful implementation of these projects," the GO stated.

Although the municipal administration sent some more names for reappointment, the GO has not been issued yet. Official sources said the govt may consider retaining some officers only after justification.
