Metro rail & stations free from betting ads: T to HC

Hyderabad: Advocate general A Sudarshan Reddy on Tuesday informed Telangana high court that they ensured that Hyderabad Metro Rail and its premises are free from any betting apps and their advertisements. Placing a memo before abench on behalf of Metro Rail, the AG said that Metro Rail would, henceforth, carry no such advertisements, as the transporter has informed the same to L&T, the concessionaire.

As per the agreement, all commercial activities of Metro rail vest with L&T. After being informed by GHMC about the betting advertisements on Metro spaces, HMRL wrote to L&T to get all such advertisements

removed, the AG said.

"This is a public private partnership project and L&T has rights over commercial space. Responding to our letter, L&T too responded positively and directed all its agencies to are move the ads. Accordingly, all such ads are now removed," the AG said. The bench posted the case to June. TNN
