

₹19,579 K-cr push for Metro Rail Phase 2

Nod to Part-B DPRs; roads too get big fillip

The Telangana Cabinet, chaired by Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy at the Secretariat on Thursday, approved the Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) for Phase 2 (Part-B) of the Hyderabad Metro Rail project. The proposed expansion spans 86.1 km and is estimated to cost ₹19,579 crore. The expansion will cover key corridors towards Medchal and Shamirpet and marks a significant step forward in the government's efforts to strengthen urban infrastructure. The DPRs, prepared and cleared by the Hyderabad Airport Metro Limited (HAML) Board on May 8, will now be submitted to the Centre for financial assistance. The project is proposed to be executed jointly with the union government. Speaking to the
