Hyd Metro Rail Phase-2 DPR under review, says NVS Reddy

The Detailed Project Report (DPR) for Hyderabad Metro Rail Phase-2(A) is currently under the central government's review, and approval for Phase-2(B) from the Telangana government is expected shortly, announced Hyderabad Metro Rail Limited (HMRL) Managing Director NVS Reddy on Sunday.
